Features

- 1% accumulation unit bonus¹.
- 7% special accumulation unit bonuses at 5th, 10th, and 15th anniversaries², dependent on premium term.

Premium term	Annual bonus applied from
5 - 7 yrs	2nd policy anniversary
8 - 11 yrs	3rd policy anniversary
12 - 15 yrs	4th policy anniversary
16 - 19 yrs	5th policy anniversary
20 - 23 yrs	6th policy anniversary
24 - 25 yrs	7th policy anniversary

Client benefits

- The more their fund value grows, the greater the bonuses.

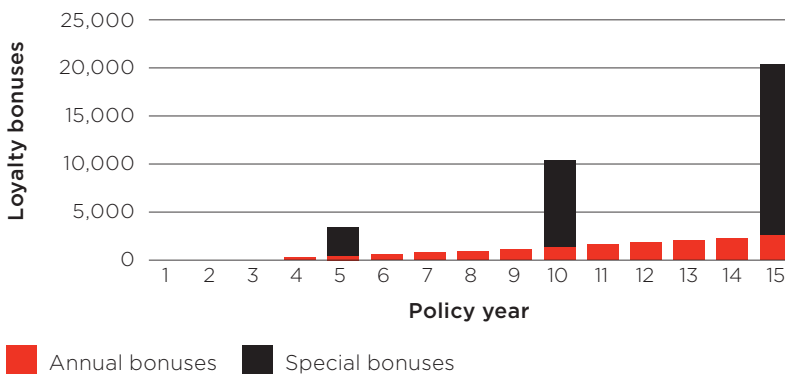
Example

Your client invests \$1,000 per month in Paragon for a term of 15 years.

On the 4th policy anniversary, and every anniversary after that, we add 1% extra accumulation units. In addition, on the 5th, 10th and 15th anniversaries we add a further 7% as shown in the example graph below.

Over the term of the policy, that's a loyalty bonus of \$45,486 – **over 25% of the premiums paid.**

The example graph shown above assumes an annual growth rate of 5.0% and is net of the policy charges and any external fund management charges that apply.
